Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1
to 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in consonance with the guidelines
dated 10.05.2023 and 05.02.2014 issued by Government of India and further to
comply with the directions issued by Hon’ble the Supreme Court of India in the
matter of ‘Lalita Kumari Vs. Government of U.P (2014) 1 SCC (Crl.) 524.

- (2) After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to
accept prayer, learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, wishes to
withdraw the petition “at this stage” with liberty to take recourse to the remedy
available under law.
