SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3 as also to decide the representation dated 02.01.2025 (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, limits his prayer and submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and take a decision on the representation (Annexure P-6) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.
3. On the strength of the advance notice, Mr. Yuvraj Singh, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents i.e. respondent Nos.1 and 2. He, however, submits he has no objection in case the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, is accepted.
4. I have heard learned counsel for the rival parties and have perused the paper-book.



5. Keeping in view the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case, and without going into merits thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala, (respondent No.2 herein) to look into the representation (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioner; consider the grievance(s) raised in the said representation & take appropriate action, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of the certified copy of this order.
6. However, if the petitioner is found to have been involved in any case, then this order shall not preclude the competent authority from taking lawful action against the petitioner.
7. The petition stands disposed off. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
