3. The petitioner joined Haryana Police Force as Constable on 13.09.1973. He was part of Tele Communication Wing. He is claiming that he should be promoted from the date his juniors were promoted. The respondent has denied his claim on the ground that he did not pass lower

school course, intermediate school course and upper school course. As petitioner did not pass any promotional course prescribed under Chapter 13 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934 (as applicable to State of Haryana) (in short 'PPR'), he was not eligible for promotion. The petitioner is claiming parity with officials who are part of District Police and have passed promotional course.

4. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has already retired on attaining the age of superannuation. The petition has rendered infructuous.

5. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the petitions are ***disposed of*** as having been rendered infructuous.

6. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application within six months from today, if cause survives.

7. Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the petitioner.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
