1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita seeking quashing of cross case vide DDR No.25 dated 06.12.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.148 dated 04.10.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 16.12.2024.

2. The following order was passed on 13.01.2025 :-

"Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita seeking quashing of cross case vide DDR No. 25 dated 06.12.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bullowal District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) in FIR No. 148 dated 04.10.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506



and 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 16.12.2024.

Notice of motion returnable for 14.02.2025.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1-State.

In the meantime, Parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate within a period of two weeks or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of the compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 14.02.2025.

This shall be the responsibility of the petitioners to get the statements of private respondents recorded before the learned trial Court.

A copy of this order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 46***, and ***Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63*** and Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (CrL) 1052***, this petition is allowed and DDR No.25 dated 06.12.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.148 dated 04.10.2019 registered under



Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners.
