This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS 2023 read with Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for quashing / setting aside the report/ speaking order dated 19.06.2024 (Annexure P-11) passed by the SSP, SAS Nagar, the same being a blatant abuse of process of law and a complete eyewash in order to hoodwink the process of law and to mislead this Court as the said report/ speaking order is based on the enquiry conducted by the SP (Hq.), SAS Nagar in haste without associating the petitioners and without appreciating the evidence in shape of audio call recordings wherein, the deceased Rajesh Kumar has specifically named the private responsible to be responsible for abetting his suicide and further, medical reports of the deceased, thereby, making the said
