SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action on the representation dated 01.01.2025 (P-6), which has been addressed by her to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar and to take legal action against the private respondents.

2. On 20.02.2025, following order was passed:

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Learned State counsel while referring the status report dated 03.02.2025 submits that when ASI Balwinder Singh reached in the hospital to record the statements of injured namely Gurwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh, the doctor informed orally that injured were not available. However, nothing has been mentioned as to whether such fact is recorded in the medical record or not because generally if patient leaves the hospital without the discharge order, the said fact is recorded in the medical record also.

Adjourned to 20.03.2025 to file additional affidavit to this effect.

3. In compliance thereto, fresh status report by way of an affidavit of Gurwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Ajnala, Amrtisar(Rural), has been filed in the Court today. Same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place with the paper-book.



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Relevant paragraph No.3, is reproduced herebelow:

“3. That it is humbly submitted that as per the treatment Charts of the injured Gurwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh, both Gurwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh had left Civil Hospital, Ajnala along with Gurwinder Singh, wherein it has been written in Treatment Notes of Gurwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh that they are leaving hospital on their own will and they will return to hospital on Monday and it was signed by Gurwinder Singh on 21.11.2024 as per the hospital record, both Gurwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh did not return for their treatment.”

4. In status report, the stand of the respondent-State is that infact police wanted to record the statements of injured Gurwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh, but both of them had left the Civil Hospital, Ajnala and in that regard a note was given in the medical record.

5. Learned State counsel also informs that infact both injured namely Gurwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh are accused in case FIR No.236 dated 21.1.2024, under Sections 109, 115(2), 18(1), 190 and 193(3) BNS, registered at Police Station Ajnala.

6. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition to enable the petitioner to take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

7. Dismissed as withdrawn as prayed for.
