HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondents, on telephonic instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the services of petitioners have been regularized and their benefits already stands released; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

[2] In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed off** accordingly.

[3] However, in case, any claim of the petitioners still survives, they would be at liberty to raise their claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of four weeks from dispatch by the concerned branch, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioners within a period of two weeks thereafter.

[4] Since, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners, let a copy of this order be sent to them by the concerned branch.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
