1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner has been taken back in service in terms of interim order dated 30.05.2013 passed by this Court, however, claim regarding her salary, for the period which she was kept out by the respondents, still remains to be readdressed, for which, he seeks liberty to file representation.

2. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise her claim regarding payment of salary by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its

receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to

the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to the petitioner from his / her own pocket.

3. Rule stands discharged.
