The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to not harass, humiliate, threaten and defame the petitioner and his family members who are residents of Agra under the garb of conducting some fictitious and vague investigation.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that the petitioner has been nominated as an accused on 24.12.2023 in FIR No.82 dated 19.11.2023 under Section 22(c) of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Verka Amritsar.

In view of the reply filed by respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, and the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed in the present case and the same is disposed of accordingly. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to invoke his alternative appropriate remedy as available to him in accordance with law for redressal of any surviving grievance.
