1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant last year's increment, which was not given to the petitioner at the time of her retirement i.e. 30.06.2011.
2. Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent, on instructions from Mr. Surinder Pal, Jr. Asstt. office of DEO(S), Jalandhar submits that in the light of letter dated 10.07.2024 issued by the Government of Punjab, necessary relief has been granted to the petitioner.
3. In light of the statement of the learned State counsel, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition. However, he submits that liberty may be granted to file application for revival of the present petition, if any cause of action still survives.
4. Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
