FAO-3499-2002 (O&M)**JAMUNA DEVI AND ORS V/S RIPPEN AHUJA AND ORS**

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Memo of Appearance on behalf of the appellants has been filed today by Mr.Neeraj Khanna, Advocate. Mr. Ramesh Kumar, brother of appellant No.1, has also filed General Power of Attorney on behalf of appellant No.1, which is taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of brother of appellant No.1, learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹7,41,000/- (₹ Seven Lakh Forty One Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the appellants that as per Aadhar Card of appellant No.1, the spelling of her name is "Jamna Devi", whereas in the Memo of Parties, the spelling of her name is mentioned as "Jamuna Devi" and hence, he requests that cheque be issued in the spelling name of "Jamna Devi". He has also produced photo copy of

Aadhar Card of appellant No.1, which is taken on the record.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹7,41,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 - Jamna Devi widow of Deepak Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 24.09.2025, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
