1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully disobeying and violating the undertaking given to this Court as recorded in the judgment dated 31.05.2002, passed in CWP No.8421 of 2002 and other connected matters.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has informed that the petitioner has joined some other Department, as such, present petition is rendered infructuous.

3. Even the petitioner-Kamal Kumar has filed application under Order XXIII Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for withdrawal of the petition, submitting therein that he does not wish to press the present petition.
