SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, seeking quashing of order dated 14.09.2022 (P-4) passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran in case FIR No.331 dated 02.09.2020, under Sections 302, 506, 148, 149 IPC(Sections 364, 201, 379-B (2), 120-B IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran(Annexure P-1), whereby petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed offender.

2. This Court has noticed that earlier prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail was declined by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 13.07.2021 passed in CRM-M-38972-2020, which shows that petitioner was well aware of pendency of proceedings against him.

3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner wishes to surrender before learned trial Court

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within a period of two weeks from today to join the process of law and further prays for deciding of regular bail application expeditiously, if any filed by the petitioner before learned trial Court.

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of having been withdrawn.

4. However, it is made clear that in case any regular bail application is filed by the petitioner before learned trial Court, same would be decided expeditiously, preferably within a period of two weeks thereafter.
