KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a challenge is thrown to the award dated 04.12.2019 (Annexure P-5), passed by the learned Permanent Lok Adalat, Chandigarh, wherethrough, a direction has been passed upon the petitioner, to correct the matriculation and Class 12th certificates of the respondent No.2, by issuing a fresh certificates with complete and full name of the father of respondent No.2, as "Suresh Chand Sharma", within a period of one month, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the award (supra).

2. The learned Permanent Lok Adalat concerned, has also burdened the petitioner, with a cost of Rs.10,000/-, to be deposited within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of the award, failing which, the



petitioner is liable to pay the interest @ 9% per annum, from the date of filing of the application, till the payment is disbursed.

3. This has caused the grievance to the petitioner and propelled it to file the instant writ petition, seeking quashing of the award (supra).

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that they are not averse by the award (supra), for making corrections. However, the said discrepancy/error in the certificates, has occurred on account of the records maintained by the respondents No.3 and 4, i.e. the concerned schools, and therefore, there is no fault on their part. He further submits that since the award has been passed, and now the certificates after requisite corrections in the name of the father of respondent No.2, has already been issued to the respondent No.2.

5. In view of the above, since the compliance of the directions of the award (supra), as passed by the learned Permanent Lok Adalat concerned, has been made, specifically, the grievance of the respondent No.2 stands addressed, and the fact that the petitioner has issued the certificates with complete and full name of the father of the respondent No.2, this Court deems it apt to modify the award (supra), and waive off the cost as imposed by the learned Permanent Lok Adalat concerned.

6. The award (supra), which is impugned before this Court, is modified accordingly, and the instant writ petition stands **disposed of**.
