1. The substantive prayer made in the instant petition reads thus:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to:

i. Allow the present petition;

ii. Direct the respondent Nos.1 to 5 to conduct independent, fair, impartial and unbiased investigation in FIR No.0155 dated 04.11.2021 under Sections 302 of The India Penal Code, 1860 (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Sector 11 West, U.T. Chandigarh by constituting Special Investigation Team or entrust the investigation in the said FIR to an independent agency like the Central Bureau of Investigation (hereinafter referred to as 'CBI') on account of the fact that no free, fair, impartial and unbiased investigation is expected from the local police;

*iii. To call for the status report and monitor such investigations as enunciated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, inter alia, in "**Babu Bhai Jamna Das Patel v. State of Gujarat; (2009) 9 SCC 610.**"*

- 2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that, since respondent No.6 stands arrested by the Chandigarh Police, he wishes to withdraw the petition in hand, at this stage.
- 3. Dismissed as withdrawn accordingly.
- 4. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
