1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.125 dated 20.12.2024, registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 376(2)(n) IPC at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 29.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigation Officer and have joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation, however, mediation remained unsettled.
