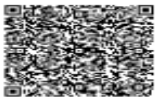
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**ALOK JAIN, J.** (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the present revision petition which was filed challenging the order dated 31.10.2018, whereby the application under Order VI Rule 17 CPC was allowed, has become infructuous on the basis of the fact that main civil suit stands adjudicated upon vide judgment and order dated 28.02.2025.

2. In the light of the above, present revision petition does not survive. Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record copy of order dated 28.02.2025 and submitted that he had informed learned counsel for the petitioners, who expressed his inability as he has gone out of station.

3. Be that as it may. Since judgment is already pronounced in the civil suit, the present petition is disposed off having been rendered



infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to seek its revival, in case, any cause of action survives.

4.. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands also disposed off.
