The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioners for seeking a directions to the respondents to grant the pay scale along with dearness allowance and other allowance (as revised from time to time) attached to the post of Fire Heavy Vehicle Driver-cum-Operator w.e.f. the date of joining at par with regular employees.

2 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this juncture, the petitioners would be satisfied in case the

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respondent-Authorities are directed to look into the advance notice dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-13) and the grievance espoused by the petitioners therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3 Notice of motion.

4 On the asking of the Court, Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 - the Director General, Fire Services, Haryana, is directed to take note of the advance demand notice dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-13) sent by the petitioners and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6 Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of four months.
