1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking quashing of FIR No.59 dated 24.08.2024 under Sections 115(2)/118(1)/3(5) of BNS registered at Police Station Sarangpur, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 08.01.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 15.01.2025 :-

"This petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking quashing of FIR No.59 dated 24.08.2024 under Sections 115(2)/118(1)/3(5) of BNS registered at Police Station Sarangpur, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 08.01.2025 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Anupam Bansal, Addl. P.P., UT Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Mr. Gursimar Singh, Advocate with Mr. Raman Sihag, Advocate has filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place. He accepts notice for respondent No.2 and



admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Service is complete.

Adjourned to 15.02.2025.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, to get recorded their statements regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 15.02.2025.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 46***, and ***Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63*** and Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (CrL.) 1052***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.59 dated 24.08.2024 under Sections 115(2)/118(1)/3(5) of BNS registered at Police Station Sarangpur, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners.
