AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. After arguing for some time, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition seeking quashing of FIR No.107 dated 09.08.2023 registered under Sections 323, 34, 342, 406, 498-A, 506 and 509 of IPC at Police Station Women West District Gurugram (Annexure P-5) as well as the challan/final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. dated 16.09.2023 presented under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 and 509 of IPC (Anneuxre P-6) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, with liberty to raise all the issues before the trial Court at the time of arguments on framing of charge sheet.

2. Petitioner had deposited Demand Draft bearing No.240615 dated 25.01.2024 for a sum of Rs.25,000/- issued by the State Bank of India Punjab and Haryana High Court Branch, Chandigarh in favour of respondent No.2 at the time of referring the matter to Mediation and Conciliation Centre. It is made clear that respondent No.2 was served but she never appeared before this Court nor she appeared before Mediation

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and Conciliation Centre.

3. In the light of this, aforesaid demand draft be returned to the petitioner as per rules, on proper receipt.

4. In view of the statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
