1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 3 for registration of FIR against respondents No.4 to 7 in accordance with law at Police Station City Moga District Moga.
2. Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Ravinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga District Moga, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions and copies thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner. Relevant extract of the reply is reproduced as under:-
