1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.129 dated 24.08.2022, registered under Sections 21, 22 and 29 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.
2. By virtue of order dated 19.02.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kamaljit Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.02.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
