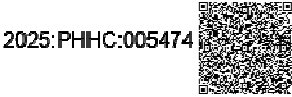

NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and directing respondents No.3 and 4 not to harass the petitioner and for taking strict legal action against respondent No.4 for his illegal activities. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner as per law in a time-bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, submits that representation of the petitioner dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) has already been considered by the SHO concerned and thereafter approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), and the same has been filed as nothing substantive has come



out from the said complaint as no proof was submitted by the petitioner to substantiate the allegations levelled in the complaint. He further submits that even otherwise, the petitioner has alternative remedy to avail under Section 173(4) of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

3. In this view of the matter, present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to avail any other legal remedy in accordance with law.
