1. Instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to respondents No. 3 and 4 for grant parole to the petitioner for a period of 08 weeks on medical ground, i.e. eye surgery.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody in case FIR No. 142 of 1999 under Section 302 Ranbir Penal Code, District Prison, Jhajjar and on account of him being advised eye surgery, he had moved an application dated 12.12.2024 before the Superintendent of Jail, District Prison, Jhajjar, Haryana, for grant of parole on medical grounds (Annexure P-3).



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Bhadu AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 5 and submits that aforesaid representation shall be considered and disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with the law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-the Superintendent of Police, District Jail, Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 12.12.2024 (Annexure P-3), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.

9. Disposed of.
