1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for quashing of impugned order dated 24.10.2017 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Nakodar, whereby warrants of attachment of the shop of the petitioner have been issued by the court.
2. Learned counsel for respondent no.1 has submitted that the petitioner has approached this Court straightaway under Article 227 of the Constitution of India without filing any specific objections.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time and after seeing that this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter and to avoid an adverse order, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to file objections before the Executing Court.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.

5. It is, however, made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of said objections and in case any such objections are filed, then it would be open for both the parties to raise all the pleas as may be available to them, in accordance with law before the Executing Court and the Executing Court would decide the same independently.
