1. This petition for grant of bail under Section 483 BNSS, has been filed by petitioner, an accused in case bearing FIR No.10 dated 16.03.2023 registered against him at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, at the instance of Amarjit Singh, son of Gurdip Singh (complainant), for the commission of offences punishable u/s 307, 506, 34 IPC (Section 302 IPC added later on).

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel wishes to withdraw the present petition, but with a request to direct the learned trial Court to expeditiously decide the case.

3. Learned State counsel and also learned counsel for the complainant, do not oppose the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.



4. Heard.

In view of the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, as also considering that the FIR in the present case was lodged in March, 2023, the instant petition is though dismissed as withdrawn, however, learned trial Court is directed to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of 06 months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
