The present Revision Petition has been filed by the defendant seeking setting aside of the order dated 30.09.2016 (Annexure P9) whereby petitioner had been convicted for violation of the injunction order.

2. Vide order dated 31.07.2025, at joint request, the matter was referred to the Mediation.

3. Report dated 04.08.2025 has been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court that the matter stands settled between the parties by way of Compromise Deed dated 04.08.2025.
