1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to retain him on the pay roll as per policy dated 06.09.2019 (Annexure P-3). He is further seeking direction to respondents to decide his appeal in a time bound manner.

2. Mr. Virender Kumar, counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to decide his appeal (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. AG, Haryana who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service.

5. With consent of learned counsel for the parties, the case is



taken up for final disposal.
