1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.275 dated 20.12.2024 registered under Sections 64(1) & 351(1) of BNS, 2023 and Section 67-A of the I.T. Act, 2000 at Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 15.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.01.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
