1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of an appropriate writ order or a direction in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No. 1 and 2 to ensure the petitioners right to life and personal liberty as enshrined under Article 21 of the Constitution of India is not violated by calling them to appear again and again before various police officers under the garb of repeated false complaints being given by respondents No. 6 and 7.
2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as sought and recorded hereabove.
