AMARJOT BHATTI, J.(Oral)

1. Petitioner Binderpal Kaur has filed petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 113 dated 23.10.2024 under Section 85 and 316(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. As per the facts of case, complainant Pankajpreet Kaur filed written complaint against her husband Randeep Singh and other members of in-laws family with allegations of mental harassment on account of demand of dowry. She submitted that her marriage was performed with Randeep Singh on 07.10.2019. Her parents had given dowry articles as detailed in FIR. Her husband and mother-in-law raised demand for cash of Rs. 5 lacs to purchase a car and for construction of house. About seven months ago, her husband left her at Village Malout by saying that she



cannot enter the matrimonial home until their demand was satisfied. Matter came before Women Cell, Sri Muktsar Sahib and with assurance of her husband and mother-in-law she was taken back in matrimonial home. On 08.02.2024, she was again given beatings for their demand of Rs. 5 lacs. Her husband kicked her and her mother-in-law slapped her. She again called her father who took her back. Her entire dowry articles were being used by her in-laws.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that petitioner has joined investigation and all dowry articles are recovered. She is still ready to join investigation as and when required.

4. Status report has been filed confirming the allegations. It was pointed out that dowry articles were to be recovered including motorcycle and LED. As per status report, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner was opposed.

Today, learned counsel representing State of Punjab confirmed that motorcycle and LED are already recovered, which are lying with Investigating Agency. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel representing respondent No. 2/complainant.

5. I have considered aforesaid factual position. Matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre, but matter could not be resolved. Fact remains that dowry articles have been recovered and petitioner being mother-in-law has joined investigation. No purpose would be served by sending her behind the bars. Therefore, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner Bindarpal Kaur is allowed. She be not arrested. In case of her arrest, she be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that

petitioner will join investigation as and when required. She will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

6. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of accordingly.
