1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No. 190, dated 13.03.2020 under Sections 420,409,467,468,471,120-B of IPC and Section 7,13,(1) (D) of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1).
2. While issuing notice of motion on 16.01.2025, this Court had noticed the following contentions:-

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and has been falsely arrayed as an accused on the basis of disclosure statement suffered by Deepak Rawat, co-accused. He next submits that even as per the case of the prosecution, the only role assigned to the petitioner was that he had prepared the documents on computer and handed over the same to Deepak Rawat, who further submitted the documents to the registration authority. He further submits that co-accused Deepak Rawat has already been granted the concession of bail vide

order dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-7) and the custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be required.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.
4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 16.01.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified underSection 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
