KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, a challenge is thrown to the intimation report dated nil (Annexure P-5), prepared by the Enquiry Officer, Flying Chief Squad, Rohtak, respondent No.3, wherein, it is intimated to the authorities concerned, regarding some embezzlement with regard to agricultural subsidy.

2. It is informed to this Court that the intimation report (supra), has been given effect to, and after considering all other circumstances, an FIR No.59 dated 29.03.2022, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC, Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani, has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions imparted to him by Inspector Radhey Shyam, Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani, submits that charges have already been framed in the FIR (supra), and now the case is



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fixed for prosecution witness.

4. Considering the subsequent development, this Court is of the considered opinion that at this stage, no intervention of this Court, seeking quashing of the intimation report is required, as much water has flown after filing of the instant petition. Further, the petitioner has liberty to raise all such pleas, which are raised before this Court, before the learned Trial Court concerned.

5. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**, with the aforesaid liberty.
