1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to get released the minor daughter of the petitioner, namely Binny, aged about 17 years, from the illegal detention of respondents No.4 to 6.

2. On 15.01.2025, following order was passed by this Court: -

“The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of direction in the nature of Habeas Corpus for getting the detenue released from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the FIR (supra) was registered on 24.07.2024 on account of missing

of minor daughter of the petitioner. The petitioner apprehends that his daughter has been detained by the private respondents and till date, the minor daughter has not been traced nor any of the accused has been arrested.

Notice of motion to official respondents i.e. respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State. A copy of the writ petition be supplied to him during the course of the day. He seeks a short accommodation to have further instructions in the matter.

4. In view of the aforesaid status report, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
