The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation by some higher officials in representation dated 26.12.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner as till date, no action has been taken on the said representation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, at the very outset, submits that the jurisdictional police authorities have received the complaint from one, Poonam, who visited the concerned police station along with the petitioner and on the basis of her complaint. He further submits that the jurisdictional police authorities are going to register the FIR, however, the petitioner has not made any complaint in writing so far, containing the allegations made in the present petition.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits

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that he would submit a written complaint before the jurisdictional police authorities within a week.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of accordingly and the jurisdictional police authorities are directed to consider the written complaint of the petitioner and decide the same within two weeks in accordance with law.
