1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Hansi in the application filed by the petitioners under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC.
