1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking quashing of FIR No. 0416 dated 03.08.2023 under Sections 379, 380, 406, 420, 452, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar along with further proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that statement of the petitioner has been recorded by the jurisdictional Court and respondent No. 2-Mr. Mahesh Sharma, has categorically stated that he has not arrived at any compromise with the accused namely Gurvinder Singh, Jaswinder Singh, Navdeep Singh, Kamalpreet Kaur, Kulwant Kaur and Malkit Singh @ Labh Singh. As such, the present petition is not maintainable as the Division Bench of this Court has clearly barred the quashing of FIR on the basis of partial compromise.

3. Dismissed being non-maintainable.



4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition seeking quashing of FIR(supra) on the basis of compromise, in case a genuine compromise is effected between the complainant with all the accused persons, in future.
