1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to decide fate of his application dated 21.09.2023 (Annexure P-5) seeking permission to withdraw his resignation.

2. The petitioner claims that on account of ill health of his wife, he filed resignation on 12.07.2023. He decided to withdraw his resignation and filed application dated 21.09.2023. The respondent has not decided fate of his application. He has served legal notice dated 01.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) but to no avail.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives



5. With consent of learned counsel for the parties, the case is taken up for final disposal.
6. Mr. Raman Sharma assures the Court that competent authority would look into application of petitioner seeking permission to withdraw resignation as well as legal notice and address the same.
7. Mr. Thakan agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.
8. In the wake of statement of both sides, writ petition stands disposed of. Let the needful be done within 2 months from today.
