1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.134 dated 02.11.2023 registered under Sections 302, 201, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station G.R.P. Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).

2. The petitioner had earlier filed a petition i.e. CRM-M-49842-2024 before this Court with similar relief. However, after arguing at length, the petition was withdrawn by the petitioner. Now, the second petition has been filed by the petitioner for the same relief without change of any circumstances and the petition is not maintainable.

3. At this stage, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has already been declared as proclaimed offender on 19.07.2025 and the concerned Court has also ordered that one FIR under Section 174 of IPC may be registered against the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, the petitioner is not entitled to the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail and the petition is ordered to be dismissed.
