The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case FIR No.117 dated 23.11.2024 under Sections 109, 118(1), 118(2), 115(2), 191(3), 190 of BNSS, 2023, registered at Police Station, Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

On 16.01.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been attributed a simple injury with a datar in the occurrence in question on the waist of the complainant. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 16.01.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 16.01.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
