The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a direction to the respondents to forward/send the petitioner's case for grant of family pension to the second respondent/Accountant General, Haryana.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the fifth respondent/Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Kuttabadh, dated 02.04.2025, which are retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. The instructions are to the following effect:

11. That the petitioner Smt. Sudesh Rani was requested by the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Kuttabadh vide letter no. 1270 dated 29.03.2024 to provide the above documents and a copy of the letter dated 30.01.2024, 14.03.2024 issued by the Principal Accountant General Haryana (A&E) Haryana was also sent to her.

16. That Principal Accountant General Haryana (A&E) Haryana vide their letter dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-11) addressed to the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Kuttabadh informed that the documents regarding the proof of the petitioner residing with and wholly dependent on her parents, Parivar Pehchan Patra and approval of the competent



authority under rule 8 (17) of HCS(Pension) Rules, 2016 be provided.

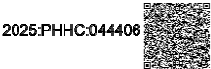
17. That the petitioner was again requested vide letter no.1403 dated 25.02.2025 by the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Kuttabadh in person to provide the following documents by hand through undersigned vide letter no. 1403 dated 25.02.2025 in order to process your family pension case and submit to the Office of Principal Accountant General (A&E), Haryana, Chandigarh w.r.t. PEN-F1/1/162121-S/457-60 dated 25.06.2024 (Copy enclosed), so that the compliance of interim orders dated 11.02.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 1617 of 2025 titled as Sudesh Vs State of Haryana & Ors. can be made accordingly.

1. The proof of dependency upon his father Lt. Sh. Hukam Chand, JBT, GPS Kuttabadh (Sirsa).
2. The income proof issued by the competent authority from the date of death of her father i.e. 25.03.2012 to 27.03.2024, year wise.
3. The reasons for not submitting any request/application for granting her the family pension case till 17.12.2021 in the Government Senior Secondary School, Kuttabadh(2982), Distt. Sirsa, provide the documents in this regards.

18. That the petitioner was again requested on 04.03.2025 by the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Kuttabadh in person to provide the above documents. But she did not provide the same and the information provided by the petitioner is attached.

By referring to the instructions, learned State counsel contends that only on account of the requisite documents having not been submitted by the petitioner, her case for grant of family pension could not be forwarded.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the requisite documents will soon be submitted to the fifth



respondent, and thereupon her case may be forwarded to the second respondent.

4. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of with a direction to the respondents to forward the petitioner’s case for grant of family pension to the second respondent within four weeks of receiving the requisite documents.
