1. The petitioner herein has filed a suit for grant of decree of permanent injunction which is pending before the trial court.
2. On a particular date of hearing, the court has refused to grant *ad-interim* injunction, however, the application filed by the petitioner under Order 39 Rule 1& 2 CPC is yet to be finally decided.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is not appropriate to interfere, at this stage. However, the learned trial court is requested to decide the application filed under Order 39 Rule 1&2 CPC within the period as mandated under Order 39 Rule 3(A) of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
4. With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
