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**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the official respondents to withhold terminal dues of late Mr. Dilpreet Singh.
2. The petitioner is mother of late Mr. Dilpreet Singh who was holding the post of DSP at the time of his death. He passed away in harness and his legal heirs are entitled to different terminal/retiral benefits. A dispute has erupted between petitioner and her daughter-in-law *qua* which a civil suit is also pending between them.
3. Mr. V. Chaitanya Rao, Advocate submits that official respondents may be directed to withhold the remaining terminal dues of late Mr. Dilpreet Singh till the conclusion of civil suit.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, pointing out order dated 29.10.2024 (Annexure P-1), submits that partial benefits have been released to all the 3 legal heirs and remaining benefits would be released after thoroughly examining applicable Rules and Regulations as well as nomination papers.

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5.           In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, findings of  
impugned order dated 29.10.2024 and pendency of civil suit between the parties,  
no further order is warranted.
