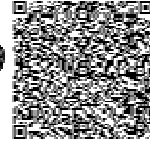

SUMEET GOEL, J. (ORAL)

The substantive prayer made in the petition in hand reads thus:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed by issuance of appropriate order or direction from this Hon’ble Court ordering the setting up of SIT to investigate and for issuance of appropriate order or direction to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 to conduct proper thoroughly fair investigation in the matter through any senior police official atleast from the rank of DCP and to take appropriate legal action in the FIR No.388 dated 27.08.2019 (Annexure P-1).”

2. Learned State counsel (on instructions from ACP Crime-II, Faridabad) submits that cancellation report was prepared on 27.04.2024 and the same has been submitted before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate on 19.07.2025, which is pending adjudication before the said Court. Learned State counsel has also filed reply by way of an affidavit dated 26.08.2025 of Satender Kumar Gupta, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, in the Court today, which is taken on record.

3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition in hand with liberty to urge all plea(s), as available in law, before the said Court.

4. In view of the above, it is directed as under:

- i) The petition in hand is dismissed as withdrawn reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner to urge plea(s), as available to him in law, before the concerned magisterial Court;
- ii) Additional Director General of Police (Law & Order), Haryana is directed to file an affidavit with the Registrar General of this Court within a period of 60 days from today regarding the status of the departmental proceedings initiated against four police officials as mentioned in para-5 of the affidavit dated 08.08.2025 filed by the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
