The present petition has been filed seeking transfer of trial bearing Case No. SC110/2022 titled as “State of Haryana versus Bhumit Samota”, in FIR No. 724 dated 07.12.2021 registered under Sections 341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3(2)(va) of the SC/ST Act, 1989 (Amendment 2015), Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, District Bhiwani.

2. Learned State Counsel informs that 11 witnesses out of a total of 13 witnesses have already been examined in the present case.

3. Even though an arduous attempt has been made by Counsel for the petitioner to submit that no Advocate is willing to accept his brief since

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the accused happens to be a practicing Advocate of the Bar Association, Bhiwani, however, the petitioner has made no averment of having ever approached any Advocate in Bhiwani for defending his case. Besides, there is also no averment in the present petition that the District Bar Association, Bhiwani had passed any resolution not to appear against the accused Advocate.

4. In the absence of any such specific averment of allegation, the submission made cannot be accepted. The same is perceived as nothing more than a self serving assertion so as to steer the trial. Such an attempt would not ordinarily be permitted. Consequently, finding no reasons, the present petition is dismissed.
