The instant petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner and her family members by unnecessary calling them to the police station and raiding their house under the garb of FIR No.265 dated 09.12.2024, under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), which was registered against the husband of the petitioner on the basis of a complaint made by respondent Nos.5 to 7.

2. Considering the nature of relief being sought in the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to file an application before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2, who shall

look into the matter and pass an appropriate order/direction in accordance

with law, preferably within a period of one month, from the date of receipt of such application.

3. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
