MAIN CASE

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner was offered appointment on 18.12.2023; however, the services of the petitioner were terminated vide impugned order dated 05.02.2025 on the pretext that in Column No.13 of the Character Verification Form, the petitioner concealed the factum of pendency of criminal case against him bearing FIR No.179 dated 28.08.2023 registered under Sections 323 and 506 read with Section 34 of the IPC. He, however, submits that the said matter was a family dispute and the same already stands resolved by way of a compromise that took place between the parties on 11.10.2023; on the basis whereof, a quashing petition was also filed. Accordingly, the petitioner made a declaration that no criminal case was pending against him. However, the complainant party resiled from honouring the terms and conditions of the said compromise. He further contends that the petitioner has been implicated in the abovesaid case but it does not involve any offence of moral turpitude and as such, the same should not stand in the way of the petitioner to continue in the job.

Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to seek instructions and to file a specific affidavit as regards issuance of appointment letter by the Government to a person against whom a criminal case is/was pending, if any.

The requisite affidavit be filed on or before the adjourned date with copy in advance to the learned counsel opposite.

The operation of the impugned order dated 05.02.2025 shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.
