1. This order will dispose of three revision petitions i.e., CR-43-2017 titled as “Saroj Rani Vs. P.A. Terly and another”; CR-54-2017 titled



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as “Yogesh Kumar Vs. P.A. Terly and another” and CR-58-2017 titled as “Jiwan Kumar Vs. P.A. Terly and another”.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners in all the above-said three petitions has submitted that the petitioners had filed civil suits in which the respondents had filed counter-claims and with respect to the counter-claims filed by the respondents, the petitioners had filed applications under Order 7 Rule 11 read with Section 151 CPC for rejection/dismissal of counter claims. It is further submitted that the civil suits are at the fag end, inasmuch as, the same are now fixed for rebuttal evidence/arguments. It is argued that in view of the same, the present petitions be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioners to raise all the pleas which have been raised in the present revision petitions and are available to them, during the course of trial.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the respondents have no objection to the said course of action and has further submitted that even the respondents be permitted to raise all the pleas in accordance with law.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present revision petitions are disposed of with the observation that it would be open to both the parties to raise all the pleas which have been raised in the present revision petitions and are available to them during the course of trial.

5. Since the civil suits are of the year 2014, the trial Court is

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requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible.

6. Counsel appearing for all the parties are also requested to fully assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the matters.
