The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.107, dated 07.09.2024, registered under Sections 109,115(2),190,191 of BNS, 2023, at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).
