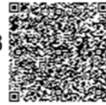

(1) Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he restricts his claim to the issuance of directions to respondent No.3 – District Revenue Officer/Collector, Jhajjar to expeditiously decide the application filed by the petitioner under Section 7 of the Haryana Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (for short - the Act) seeking therein the eviction of the private respondents from the land which, according to the petitioner, the private respondents have encroached upon.

(2) The aforesaid application under Section 7 of the Act was filed by the petitioner on 25.02.2021 and is pending adjudication for the last over 04 years.



(3) Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection to the acceptance of the petitioner's afore prayer.

(4) The petitioner's application filed by him under Section 7 of the Act is pending before respondent No.3 since 25.02.2021. Every litigant has a right to a speedy disposal of the *lis* initiated by him-her/pending against him/her. A direction to adjudicate upon a *lis* expeditiously also prejudices none. Rather, a direction issued to decide a *lis* pending between the parties at an early stage is in the interest of both the parties. Therefore, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - District Revenue Officer/Collector, Jhajjar to finally dispose of the application filed by the petitioner under Section 7 of the Act within 03 months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.
